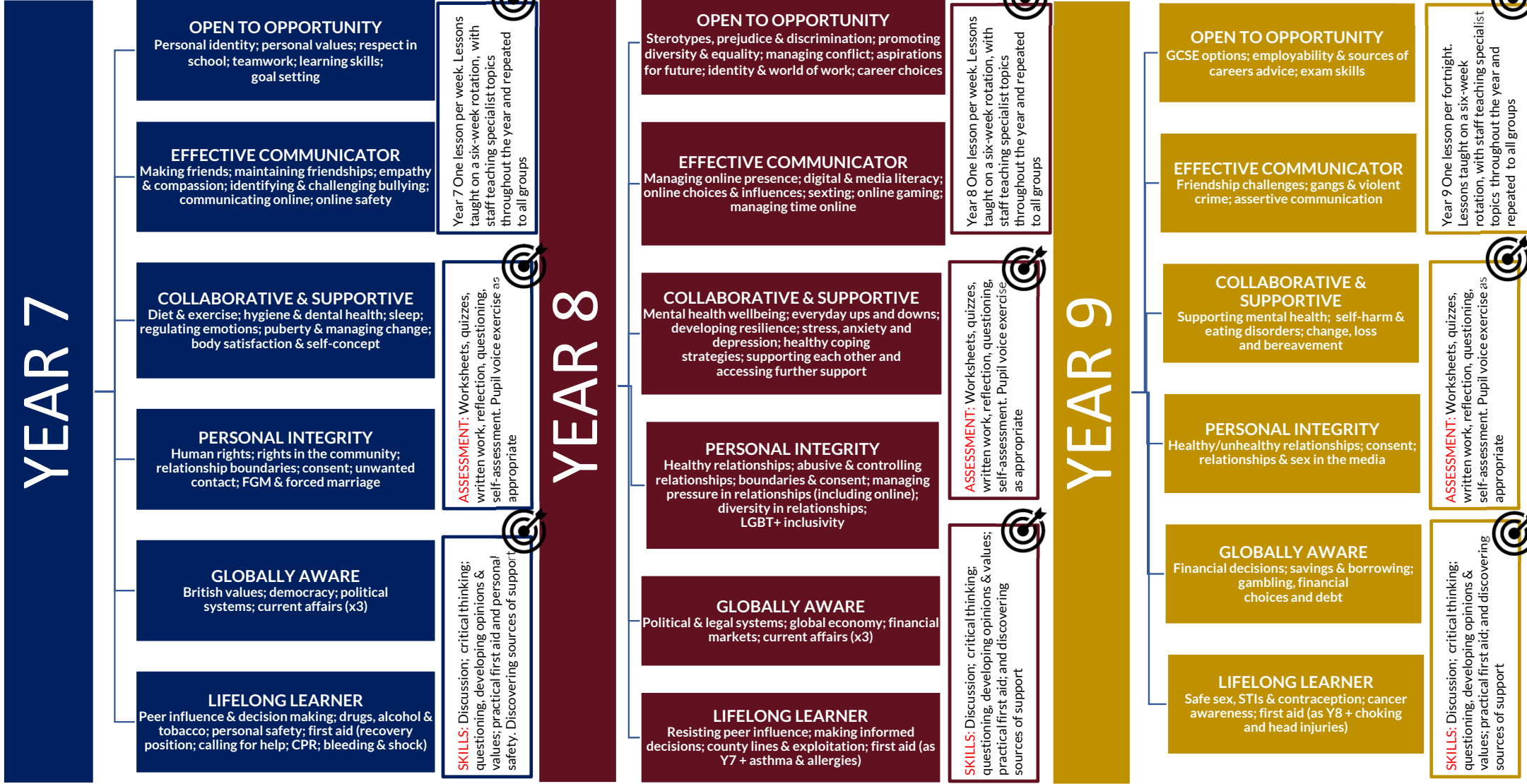

### YEAR 10

**CONTENT**
