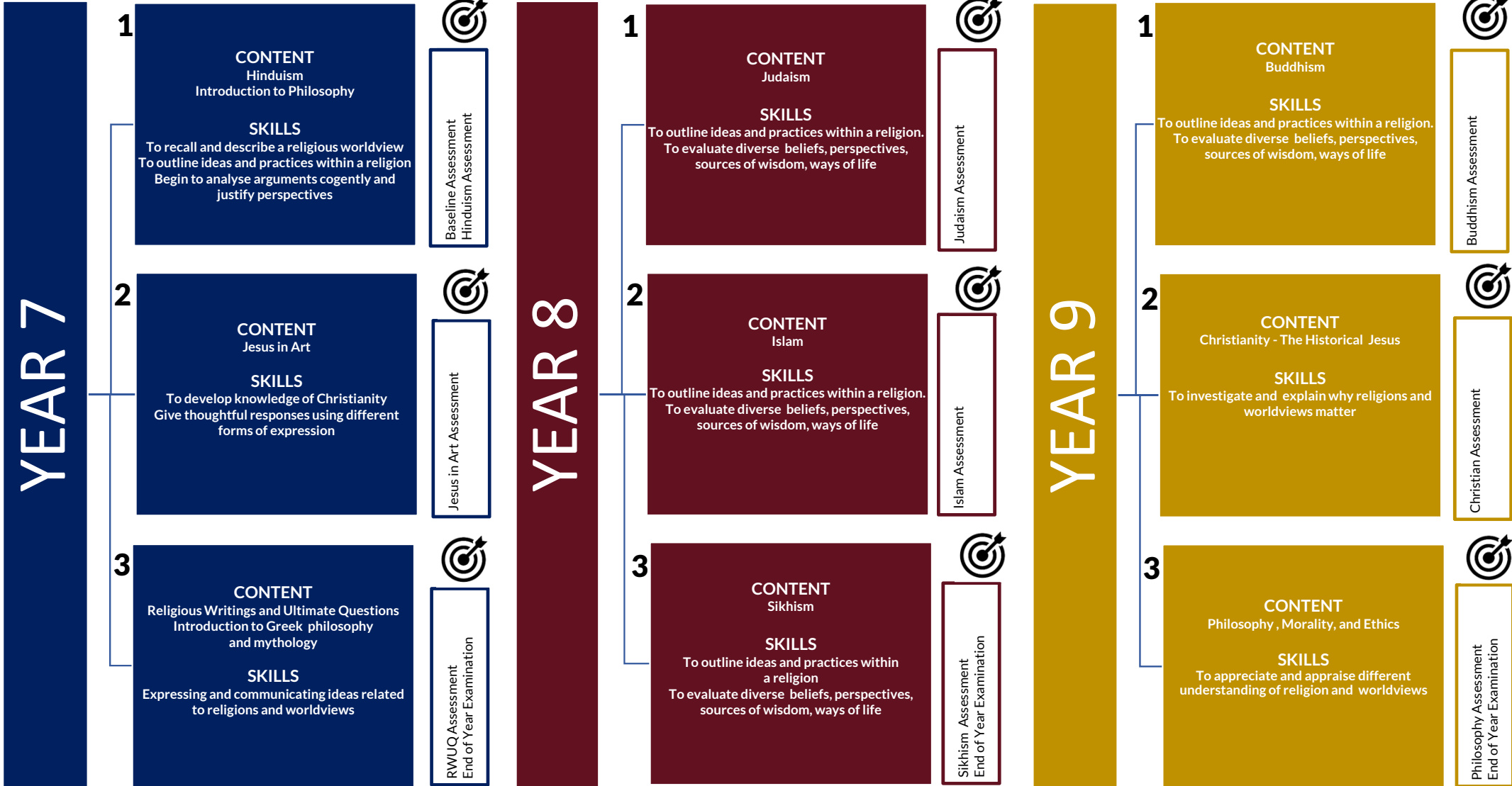


WHSB RELIGIOUS STUDIES LOWER SCHOOL CURRICULUM MAP
